



AHCCHM101 Follow Basic Chemical Safety Rules

OBJECTIVE

This nationally accredited course will provide participants with the understanding and knowledge of how to effectively manage chemicals in the workplace in accordance with the International Standard "Global Harmonisation Systems" that Australia is a signatory to .

The aim of the course is to give participants the skills to prepare to work with chemicals, Identify the Risks associated with workplace Chemicals and Understand and follow chemical handling and storage rules

It will also assist managers, supervisors and workers to comply with relevant storage and handling requirements for hazardous substances and dangerous goods.

WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE?

Individuals requiring a working knowledge of chemical safety.

COURSE CONTENT

Upon completion of the training participants will have an understanding of:

- Identifying hazardous substances and dangerous goods in the workplace
- Identify properties and characteristics of workplace chemicals from labels and safety data sheets
- Correctly label chemical containers
- Conduct a chemical risk assessment
- Prepare a register for hazardous substances and/or dangerous goods
- Assess the health risks of hazardous substances and dangerous goods
- Manage workplace chemicals
- Understanding the chemical compatibility tables
- Emphasise the responsibilities involved in the storage and handling of chemicals
