



# Asbestos Awareness

## OVERVIEW

The aim of this training is to provide participants with the required knowledge and understanding of the hazards and risks associated with asbestos and its removal.

This course provides the skills and knowledge necessary to identify asbestos containing materials (ACMs) or suspected ACMs, and to ensure that appropriate action is taken.

Explains why exposure to asbestos **MUST** be avoided; Emphasis on what to do if a suspected ACM is identified.

Any person looking to work with or around asbestos containing materials.

Upon completion of the training participants will have an understanding of:

- Identifying the different types of Asbestos
- Legislative aspects of Asbestos removal and control
- What to do if ACM is suspected

- Utilising an asbestos removal control plan
- Planning the Removal of Asbestos
- Procedures for the Removal of Asbestos
- Procedures for site and equipment maintenance
- Identify and select the method of transportation and disposal of asbestos
