FIRE WARDEN

OBJECTIVE

This course is designed for employees or supervisors / managers who are required to undertake the duties of a warden during an emergency situation. Individuals who undertake this training will be competent to implement the workplace procedures or instructions during a workplace emergency situation.

WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE

All personnel who are required to act as a warden/fire warden in the workplace

COURSE CONTENT

- Human behaviour at fires and other emergencies
- Planning and preparation in the event of an emergency
- Evacuation procedures
- The duties of the emergency control organisation
- Alarms
- Training requirements
- Authority of a warden
- Identification of portable firefighting equipment.
- Correct positioning of fire appliances.
