



# FIRE WARDEN

## OBJECTIVE

This course is designed for employees or supervisors / managers who are required to undertake the duties of a warden during an emergency situation. Individuals who undertake this training will be competent to implement the workplace procedures or instructions during a workplace emergency situation.

## WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE

All personnel who are required to act as a warden/fire warden in the workplace

## COURSE CONTENT

Upon completion of the training participants will have an understanding of:

- Human behaviour at fires and other emergencies
- Planning and preparation in the event of an emergency
- Evacuation procedures
- The duties of the emergency control organisation
- Alarms
- Training requirements
- Authority of a warden
- Identification of portable firefighting equipment.
- Correct positioning of fire appliances.

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<b>Pre-requisites</b>	Nil
<b>Duration</b>	4 Hours
<b>Qualification</b>	Upon successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Completion: <i>Fire Warden</i>
<b>When to Arrive</b>	It will be helpful if you can arrive at least 10 minutes before the scheduled start time.
<b>What to Wear</b>	All course participants are required to wear appropriate work attire.
<b>Morning Tea and Lunch</b>	Feel free to grab a tea or coffee before the course starts and at any time during the course. Participants will be offered morning tea. There is a range of lunch bars within walking distance.
