



Attach Cords & Plugs

OBJECTIVE

This unit covers attaching flexible cords and plugs to electrical equipment for connection to supplies up to 230V ac. It encompasses working safely, identifying plug configurations, selecting and using testing and measuring devices, terminating and connecting cords/plugs and conductors, safety testing and reporting.

COURSE CONTENT

The Attach Cords and Plugs course has been divided into distinct sections. Upon completion of the training participants will have an understanding of how to:

- Plan and prepare to attach flexible cord(s) and plug(s)
- Attach flexible cord(s) and plug(s)
- Test equipment for operation and safety
- Locate and repair fault(s) in attached flexible cord(s) and plug(s)

Qualification

Upon successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment: *UEENEEP024A Attach cords and plugs to electrical equipment for connection to a single phase 230 volt supply*, which is nationally recognised
