



Leadership in WHS

OBJECTIVE

Supervisors and frontline managers play a vital role in achieving and maintaining safety standards in the workplace. They are key advocates in promoting a culture in which safety is a priority and workplace injuries are not acceptable.

This course will provide the knowledge necessary to meet legislative requirements, ensure a safe workplace and implement or monitor company Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) policies, procedures and programs.

- Diagnose and solve routine and non-routine problems
- Assess and identify unacceptable risk
- Understand and apply knowledge of OHS legislation
- Conduct workplace Investigations and Inspections
