



Workplace First Aid

COURSE OBJECTIVE

The aim of this training is to develop the skills and knowledge required to provide first aid response, life support, management of casualty(s), the incident and other first aiders, until the arrival of medical or other assistance.

WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE

Anyone currently requiring First Aid skills and knowledge

COURSE CONTENT

This Industry based First Aid course covers a broad range of topics to enable participants to confidently manage emergency situations by providing care for the ill or injured until medical aid arrives. This course applies to everyone and is suitable for employees, employers and members of the public who want or require training in first aid. This course has a deliberate workplace focus.

Most workplaces require a specific number of people to successfully complete this qualification. The qualification remains current for three years, during which time a First Aid refresher course can be undertaken.

Qualification	Upon successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment: <i>HLTF301C Apply First Aid</i> . Which is nationally recognised.
When to Arrive	It will be helpful if you can arrive at least 10 minutes before the scheduled start time.
What to Wear	All course participants are required to wear appropriate work attire.
