



Identify requirements for Safe Tilt Up Construction

OBJECTIVE

The aim of this training is to provide participants with the necessary knowledge and skills to equip them to safely work in tilt-up construction.

The course provides meaningful theoretical instruction to help participants understand the hierarchy of hazard control and specific hazards associated with Tilt-up construction and the Code of Practice.

WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE

This course is a legal requirement for people that are involved in the manufacture, storage, transport, erection and tilt-up and pre-cast panels.

COURSE CONTENT

This course is based on the requirements outlined in the OH&S Act, Regulations, Code of Practice, Standards and includes:

- Tilt-up construction risk management process
- Identification of hazards, and assessing and addressing risks
- Access and usage of information relating to safe tilt-up construction
- Codes of Practice and Standards
- Maintain safety of self and others
- Emergency Response Procedures
- Roles & responsibilities of all parties involved in tilt-up construction

Pre-requisites

It is required that you have obtained the Work Safely in the Construction Industry CPCCOHS1001A (White Card) obtained after September 2009, a copy of the card or Statement of Attainment is required prior to commencement of the course.

Duration

6 Hours

Qualification

Upon successful completion participants will be issued with a Statement of Attainment: *CPCCCM1016A Identify requirements for safe tilt up work.*

When to Arrive

It will be helpful if you can arrive at least 10 minutes before the scheduled start time.

What to Wear

All course participants are required to wear appropriate work attire.
