# Work safely in the construction Industry (White Card)

### OBJECTIVE

The Occupational Health and Safety Regulations 1996 set out mandatory requirements for the provision of construction safety induction training.

If you work in the Construction Industry in Australia it is a legal requirement to obtain this qualification prior to entering any construction site. CPCCOHS 1001A is a nationally recognised course.

The National Construction Induction course covers the legalities and responsibilities for working in the building and construction industry.

### WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE

Anyone currently working or intending on working on a construction site

### COURSE CONTENT

This course is based on the requirements outlined in the OH&S Act, Regulations, Code of Practice and Standards and includes:

- Identify OH&S legislative requirements
- Identify construction hazards and control measures
- Identify OH&S communication and reporting processes
- Identify OH&S incident response procedures

4-6 Hours reviewing the manual and approximately 30 to 40 minutes completing the online exam

#### Qualification

Upon successful completion participants will be issued with the following Statement of Attainment : **Work Safely in the Construction Industry CPCCOHS1001A**, which is recognised nationally and a worksafe approved Occupational Health and Safety Construction Induction Card.
